The Foundation Phase in Ysgol Penrhyn Dewi strives to provide a welcoming, caring, safe and engaging environment for all children and parents who are or become part of our school community.

### What is the Foundation Phase?

The Foundation Phase is a developmental curriculum for children aged three to seven in Wales. This phase is about developing a solid base of knowledge and skills for your child to develop throughout their school life. It encourages creativity, imagination, independence, decision-making, thinking and exploration. It makes learning fun and gives children the opportunity to learn through practical activities appropriate to their developmental stage.

### What is my child learning?

The existing Foundation Phase has seven areas of learning, which are delivered through stimulating, structured activities and practical experiences both indoors and out.

- 1. Personal and Social Development, Well-being and Cultural Diversity.
- 2. Language, Literacy and Communication
- 3. Mathematical Development
- 4. Welsh Language Development
- 5. Knowledge and Understanding of the World
- 6. Physical Development
- 7. Creative Development

Alongside the existing Foundation Phase, guidance for the new curriculum for Wales, which is due to be implemented by September 2022 has now been published. As a school we have began our journey in developing our own unique curriculum, which will focus the on the four purposes and better support all our children with the



foundations needed to succeed in our ever changing world.

#### Supporting your child at home

- Use and check Class Dojo daily to see your child's progress and keep up to date with up coming events and the latest information.
- Check with your child to see if they have had any letters.
- Read with your child daily even if it is just two or three pages of their reading book. Research shows that reading makes a huge impact on your child's progress, especially if you start when your child is young. For further information and advice please ask for a copy of our reading leaflet.
- If your child is learning their sounds or numbers support this by going on a number hunt, collecting interesting items to count, playing I spy, listening for sounds in the environment etc.
- Ensure your child attends school and arrives on time, their learning begins from the very start of the school day.
- Where possible attend school events, particularly parents evening.
- If you are worried about anything, go and talk to the class teacher, they will want to help.
